Program Description

This career choice is ideal for the person who wants to achieve NATIONAL certifications to become a CPhT- Certified Pharmacy Technician. This 16 week training program will introduce the student to medication order processing, inventories, compounding and packaging, use of a prescription balance, HIPAA privacy act and computers. Upon completion of the course, you will have knowledge and skills in the areas of drug regulation and control, formulation, pharmaceutical terminology, and units of measurement. Modules include Pharmacy History, The Career, The Setting, Legal and Ethical Issues, The Terminology, Common Drugs and their Uses, Medical Terminology, Organization of the Body, Suffixes and Appendices, Prefixes and Appendices, Digestive System, Pathology Diagnostic Testing of the Digestive System, Urinary System, Female Reproductive System, Male Reproductive System, Nervous System, Cardiovascular System, Respiratory System, Blood System, Lymphatic and Immune Systems, Musculoskeletal System, Integumentary System, Sensory Organs, Endocrine System, Oncology, Radiology and Nuclear Medicine, Pharmacology, and Psychiatry. Students have the option to complete a 6-week externship with WALGREENS or CVS!

People with the CPhT certification can perform the following tasks.

- Receive and process prescription requests from patients, and those sent electronically from doctors' offices
- Accurately count, weigh, pour and mix medications
- Prepare accurate prescription labels
- Prepare and Process insurance claim forms and manage inventory
- Establish and maintain patient profiles as well as computerized patient records
